

Adding Adeptia Server as Windows Service

This document describes the steps to be followed to add Adeptia Suite as windows Services.

Note: Paths illustrated in this document are used assuming that Adeptia Server is installed in default directory which is *C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite*.

Steps to add Adeptia Server as Windows Service

1. Copy *jsl-Kernel.ini* and *jsl-WebRunner.ini* files in to *C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite\AdeptiaServer-ServerKernel* folder.
2. Edit *jsl-Kernel.ini* in any text editor and change the highlighted path according to the folder in which you have installed Adeptia Server. See figure below:

appname = Adeptia Suite Kernel
servicename = Adeptia Suite Kernel
displayname = Adeptia Suite Kernel
starttype = auto
loadordergroup = someorder
stopclass = com/adeptia/indigo/Shutdown
stopmethod = main
stopsignature = ([Ljava/lang/String;)V
systemout = C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite\AdeptiaServer-5.0\ServerKernel\Kernel-out.log
systemoutappend = yes
systemerr = C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite\AdeptiaServer-5.0\ServerKernel\Kernel-err.log
systemerrappend = yes

[java]
jrepath = C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite\jre\
wrkdir = C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite\AdeptiaServer-5.0\ServerKernel
params = 5
param00 = -cp
param01 = C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite\AdeptiaServer-5.0\ServerKernel\web\libs\BPMServer.jar;C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite\AdeptiaServer-5.0\ServerKernel\etc
param02 = com.adeptia.indigo.loader.ApplicationLauncher
param03 = KN
param04 = 1
```

3. Save the file and close it.
4. Similarly edit *jsl-webRunner.ini* in any text editor and change the highlighted path according to the folder in which you have installed Adeptia Server. See figure below:

appname = Adeptia Suite WebRunner
servicename = Adeptia Suite WebRunner
displayname = Adeptia Suite WebRunner
starttype = auto
loadordergroup = someorder
stopclass = java/lang/System
stopmethod = exit
stopsignature = (I)V
systemout = C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite\AdeptiaServer-5.0\ServerKernel\WebRunner-out.log
systemoutappend = yes
systemerr = C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite\AdeptiaServer-5.0\ServerKernel\WebRunner-err.log
systemerrappend = yes

[java]
jrepath = C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite\jre\
wrkdir = C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite\AdeptiaServer-5.0\ServerKernel
params = 4
param00 = -cp
param01 = C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite\AdeptiaServer-5.0\ServerKernel\web\libs\BPMServer.jar;C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite\AdeptiaServer-5.0\ServerKernel\etc
param02 = com.adeptia.indigo.loader.ApplicationLauncher
param03 = WB

```

5. Save the file and close it.
6. Now go to command prompt and run the following command
"C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite\jre\bin\jstl.exe" -install "C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite\AdeptiaServer-5.0\ServerKernel\jstl-Kernel.ini"

See figure below:

```

C:\>"C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite\jre\bin\jstl.exe" -install "C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite\AdeptiaServer-5.0\ServerKernel\jstl-Kernel.ini"

```

This should display a message that Adeptia Suite Kernel installed as windows service.

7. Now run the following command:

```

"C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite\jre\bin\jstl.exe" -install "C:\Program Files\AdeptiaSuite\AdeptiaServer-5.0\ServerKernel\jstl-WebRunner.ini"

```

This should display a message that Adeptia Suite WebRunner installed as windows service.

8. Restart the system.
